School Rules

School Rules

Rules are not invented by Board of Management or teachers just to torment pupils or to make life miserable ... a little common sense will show that they are there to safeguard.... therefore we expect:

- 1. That children come to school every day and arrive on time. This means:
 - That the boys attend school everyday unless it is absolutely unavoidable;
 - That if boys miss school they bring in a note or a Doctor's Certificate;
 - That if boys must leave school during the day, they bring a note from parents signed and dated or are collected by parents who 'sign them out'
 - That boys arrive on time and not delay and respond promptly to the bell ending break times.

2. That children do their best to work both in class and at their homework. This means:

- That the boys listen to their teachers;
- That they don't disturb the class;
- That boys do their homework each night, written or oral;
- That boys always use their homework journal to take down their homework:
- That boys get it signed daily by their parents.

3. That children come in properly prepared. This means:

- That the boys have the proper pens, books and copies;
- That they carry them in a schoolbag;
- That they bring in any special equipment/clothing needed.
- 4. That the boys come to school in complete uniform, clean and tidy (green school jumper, grey trousers, green tie, grey shirt; school tracksuits and polo shirts on P.E. days. This means:
 - That the boys don't drag in mud or dirt;
 - That boys wear suitable clothing in changeable weather;
 - That coats, bags, jumpers etc. are all clearly labelled.
 - That all jewellery, including earrings are not allowed in school.

5. That children have respect and consideration for other pupils. This means:

- Being helpful and treating others with good manners and respect;
- · Not picking-on or bullying others;
- Not fighting;
- That boys don't push and shove their way around;
- That boys respect other pupils' property.

6. That children respect the instructions of their teachers. This means:

- That the boys are courteous and respectful to them;
- That it applies especially when accompanied by teachers outside the school.

7. That children act in a proper manner around the school. This means:

- Walking in an orderly way between rooms along the corridor;
- Waiting quietly in line before entering classrooms;
- Playing in the area allocated;

8. That the boys are tidy and careful with school property. This means:

- That they don't break, damage or deface school property;
- When using equipment or books, returning them tidily after the class;
- Taking pride in the appearance of the school and avoiding litter;
- That glass containers or cans are never brought in to school;
- That chewing gum is never brought to school.

N.B.: Our school rules and school policies are still evolving and for that reason we review and evaluate all of them regularly.
